## UPDATES

**10/10/18:** CN has informed the Town of Stony Plain the closing of 50th Street is required at 9 a.m. tomorrow morning (Thursday, October 11) in order to complete emergency track work. The closure will be in place for at least 1.5 hours. Please use alternate routes during this time. Questions and concerns can be directed to CN's public inquiries line at 1-888-888-5909.

**08/24/2018:** CN has now informed the Town the overnight work will be pushed back to Monday, August 27. There will be no overnight work this weekend.

**08/24/2018:** CN has informed the Town of Stony Plain the dates of the overnight construction work have been changed to August 25 - September 12.

**08/20/2018:** The Town has been notified of overnight construction work on the CN double track project from August 23-September 10.

**07/13/2018:** The Town of Stony Plain has been notified CN will be switching to night closures for upcoming rail twinning work. The updated times are as follows:

- July 19 — Rosenthal Rd: 8PM-8AM
- July 23 — 50th St/Main St: 8PM-8AM
- July 28 — 48th St/HWY 779: 8PM-8AM

**06/29/2018:** The Town of Stony Plain has received notification from CN of the following crossing closures for the rail twinning project:

- July 4 - Veterans Blvd
- July 11 - Golf Course Rd
- July 19 - Rosenthal Rd
- July 23 - 50<sup>th</sup> St/Main St
- July 28 - 48<sup>th</sup> St/HWY 779

CN will set up message boards one week in advance of these closures. Please keep in mind these dates are subject to change; however, the Town and CN will continue to work together to keep residents as up to date as possible.

**05/29/2018:** Canadian National Railway (CN) has informed the Town of Stony Plain they will be doing work outside of standard construction hours on Thursday, May 31 between 3AM and 11AM. CN crews along with independent contractors will be working in the existing CN yard,

which is just east of 50th Street. CN has expressed their apologies for any inconvenience this may cause our residents. Questions can be directed to CN's public inquiries line at 1-888-888-5909.

**05/14/2018:** Stony Plain Town Council has agreed to match up to \$25,000 in potential funding to meet the requirements of Canadian National Railway's EcoConnexions Grant for a maximum budget of \$50,000.
