



Glenn Hall Centennial Arena *Rules & Regulations*

- 1) All persons using the Glenn Hall Centennial Arena assume all risk(s).
The Town of Stony Plain shall not be held liable for any accidents or injuries.
- 2) Food and drinks are not permitted on the ice surface.
- 3) Smoking is prohibited everywhere within the facility.
- 4) Glass containers, chewing gum, sunflower seeds and chewing tobacco are not permitted anywhere within the facility.
- 5) Alcohol is not permitted anywhere within the Arena except for special events, conditional to advance written permission from the Town of Stony Plain and a valid liquor licence from the Alberta Liquor and Gaming Commission.
- 6) Non-prescription drugs and tobacco products are not permitted anywhere within the Arena.
- 7) Persons who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or narcotics shall be denied admission.
- 8) Unsupervised and disruptive individuals shall be asked to leave the facility.
- 9) Animals are not permitted in the building, with the exception of guide dogs.
- 10) Foul language and spitting are strictly prohibited.
- 11) Skate assists are permitted only for beginner skaters during public skating sessions.
- 12) Hockey sticks, pucks, balls and other items that may interfere with the safety of other skaters are not permitted during public skating sessions.
- 13) Running, pushing, causing undue disturbance, horseplay involving sticks, pucks, balls or other items and any conduct that may endanger the welfare of oneself or other patrons are prohibited.
- 14) Arena staff shall have authority to enforce all facility rules and to create additional rules to ensure public safety.
- 15) The Glenn Hall Centennial Arena and the Town of Stony Plain reserve the right to refuse play and/or service to anyone.
