

BYLAW 2630/TAX/20

**BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STONY PLAIN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO IMPOSE A SUPPLEMENTARY TAX RATE FOR ALL IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE TOWN OF STONY PLAIN**

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WHEREAS pursuant to Section 369 of the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c. M-26 and amendments thereto, if in any year a council passes a bylaw authorizing supplementary assessments to be prepared in respect of property, the council must, in the same year, pass a bylaw authorizing it to impose a supplementary tax in respect of that property;

AND WHEREAS Council has passed Bylaw 2629/AS/20;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Stony Plain, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled enacts as follows:


1. The tax rates set by the annual property tax bylaw be imposed as the supplementary tax rates on all improvements located in the municipality.
2. If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.
3. Bylaw 2606/TAX/19 is hereby repealed.
4. This bylaw shall take full force and effect upon passage of third and final reading and upon signing in accordance with Section 213, *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c. M-26 and amendments thereto,
