CHECKLISTS

Required information for a complete security **reduction** application:

- Complete and signed application form
- Construction Completion Certificates (CCC), submitted by the consulting Professional Engineer
- Letter from consulting engineer outlining:
 - Any deficiencies associated with the local improvements
 - Remaining construction costs associated with the outstanding and deficient local improvements
 - Breakdown of **actual** cost of local improvements (Asset Template Sheet)

Required Information for a complete security **return** application:

- Complete and signed application form
- Final Acceptance Certificates (FAC), submitted by the consulting Professional Engineer
- Breakdown of **actual** cost of Local Improvements (if not submitted at CCC)
- Estimated cost of outstanding deficiencies, if applicable

Frequently Asked Questions:

How do I know if I qualify for a reduction or return of my security?

Your development agreement will specify if and when you can apply for a reduction or return of your security. As well, the Town of Stony Plain has a Development Agreement Security Policy that establishes the framework for the collection and release of security.

Definitions:

Construction Completion Certificate (CCC): A certificate issued by the consulting engineer and accepted by the Town. It is the process of determining if local improvements included as part of a development agreement are fully complete and are constructed to the appropriate municipal standards. Please refer to the Municipal Development Standards for further detail.

Construction cost estimate: the expected cost for construction and installation of local improvements, to be included in the development agreement.

Design drawing: detailed engineering drawings, plans, and specifications prepared by a professional engineer covering the design, construction, location, and installation of all local improvements that conform to municipal standards.

Record drawing: final as-built engineering drawings, plans, and specifications prepared by a professional engineer showing the location of all local improvements constructed as part of a development.

Final Acceptance Certificate (FAC): A certificate issued by the consulting engineer and accepted by the Town. It indicates the expiration of the warranty period and acceptance of local improvements to fully transfer municipal improvements from a developer to the Town.

Municipal/local improvement: new or replacement construction projects intended to upgrade or improve certain conditions within residential, commercial, or industrial areas within the Town. There are different types of local improvements covered under a development agreement including:

- Underground (water distribution systems, sanitary sewer systems, storm sewer systems)
- Surface (earthworks and berming, sidewalk, curb and gutter, granular base, asphalt, fencing, signage)
- Landscaping (landscaping and maintenance)

Security: a fee imposed by the Town and collected from a developer as evidence of insurance coverage ensuring the developer performs obligations agreed to under a development agreement.

Warranty period: A period of at least two (2) years for all local improvements that begins upon CCC being issued and expires when the Town issues the FAC.
