BYLAW 2716/G/25

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF STONY PLAIN IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A GROWTH AND COMMERCE COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the *Municipal Government Act*, RSA 2000, c. M-26, and amendments thereto, provides that a Council may, by bylaw, establish Council committees and other bodies; and

WHEREAS, Council may, by bylaw, delegate certain powers, duties, or functions under the *Municipal Government Act* to a Council committee; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Stony Plain adopted a Committee Governance Framework bylaw to provide structure and guidance for the establishment of Council Committees; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Stony Plain wishes to establish a Growth and Commerce Committee and to prescribe a mandate, terms of reference, and composition for the committee;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Stony Plain in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, hereby enacts the following:

1.0.0 Title

1.1.0 This bylaw may be cited as the "Growth and Commerce Committee Bylaw".

2.0.0 Establishment

2.1.0 That the Growth and Commerce Committee is hereby established.

3.0.0 General

- 3.1.0 That the Terms of Reference of the Growth and Commerce Committee are hereby set out as Schedule A attached to and forming part of this bylaw.
- 3.2.0 That the Growth and Commerce Committee shall follow the Committee Governance Framework Bylaw for any matters not identified within this bylaw.

4.0.0 Severability

4.1.0 If any portion of this bylaw is declared invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.

5.0.0 Review

5.1.0 This bylaw shall be reviewed within its fifth year, being 2030, or as deemed necessary.

6.0.0 Effective Date

6.1.0 This bylaw shall take full force and effect on the date it is passed.

Growth and Commerce Committee Terms of Reference

1.0 Purpose:

- 1.1 The Growth and Commerce Committee will identify, support and advise Council on opportunities to create a successful commercial, industrial, and residential climate in Stony Plain through:
 - a. Actively expanding knowledge of Economic Development to effectively support the implementation of the Economic Development Strategy + Action Plan.
 - b. Attending target sector industry events and conferences to stay informed about emerging trends and opportunities, gather industry insights and elevate Stony Plain's presence to attract potential investments.
 - c. Engaging in formalized business visitation processes, events, workshops, and meetings to strengthen collaboration with the local business community.

2.0 Objectives:

- 2.1 The committee will achieve its purpose by:
 - a. Facilitating Strategic Discussions Create a platform for meaningful discussions on economic development, ensuring that diverse perspectives are considered to guide the implementation of the Economic Development Strategy + Action Plan.
 - b. **Strengthening Collaborative Networks** Foster collaboration between the Town and the local business community through active participation in business visitations, workshops, and other engagement activities to strengthen partnerships and collaborations.
 - c. Keeping Administration Informed Continuously gather and share industry intelligence to keep the organization informed of emerging trends and opportunities, ensuring that Stony Plain remains adaptable and proactive in its economic development efforts.
 - d. **Providing Informed Advice** Advise on implementing the Economic Development Strategy + Action Plan by offering insights and recommendations based on experiences, knowledge and awareness of economic and industry trends.

3.0 Membership:

- 3.1 The Growth and Commerce Committee will consist of:
 - a. Three (3) members of Council
 - b. Chief Administration Officer, or designate (non-voting)

4.0 Meetings:

- 4.1 Meetings will be held bi-monthly at a date and time established by Administration in consultation with the Committee.
 - a. Meetings will be held at the Town of Stony Plain Council Chambers.
 - b. Quorum shall consist of a simple majority of total current sitting members.
 - c. The Chair will be the Chief Administrative Officer.

5.0 Evaluation/Reporting:

- 5.1 The Growth and Commerce Committee will report to Town Council through meeting minutes and member committee reports shared with Council colleagues.
- 5.2 The Committee will evaluate its ability to meet its objectives through:

- a. Quality and value of committee insights, information, and discussions that influence the implementation of the Economic Development Strategy + Action Plan.
- b. Committee's ability to raise awareness, generate support and influence economic development within the organization, community, region and beyond.
- c. Committee participation in business visits, number of relationships and partnerships formed and business satisfaction.
- d. an annual committee member evaluation survey.

6.0 Meeting Procedures

- 6.1 The Economic Development Business Unit will provide administrative support to the committee.
- 6.2 The Town's Procedural Bylaw shall guide meeting proceedings.
