Does poverty exist in Stony Plain?

Yes, 11% of us are living in poverty.¹

The Poverty Line in Stony Plain is **\$55,854.²**

If we are working, can we still be poor?

Yes, our living wage is \$24.30.³

This is the hourly wage needed while working full time to afford basic living and participate in community life.

Do people in Stony Plain go hungry?

Yes, 1229 of us⁴

used the food bank in 2025.

Often more than once.

Is there homelessness in Stony Plain?

Yes, 7 of us⁵

live outside without shelter.

379 of us live at risk of homelessness, including **116** children.

Poverty impacts our whole community.

Awareness and understanding help us grow stronger together.
